
# Pastor's Message

## Happy Feast Day!

On Friday, June 8<sup>th</sup> we celebrated our parish patronal feast, the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. Sometime ago I said that, in preparation for building a new church dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we need to increase of our devotion both as a parish and as individual parishioners. If we are going to build a new church for the glory of God, and not for our own glory, this spiritual preparation is more important than the work of the parish New Build Committee and more essential than any financial preparation. To this end, we continue to pray the Litany of the Sacred Heart each Tuesday as we begin Adoration after the 7:00pm evening Mass. During Lent a number of parishioners watched a series of videos on the devotion to the Sacred Heart. On the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ I preached about the connection between the Eucharist and our devotion to the Sacred Heart and why it was fitting for our parish to hold a Corpus Christi procession, which by all accounts was a great success. In honour of our feast day, Adoration was extended to 3:00pm. Given that the Sacred Heart of Jesus is the source of Divine Mercy, we added the Litany of Trust composed by the Sisters of Life prior to the Benediction. After Adoration, the pilgrims, which included parishioners as well as university students from the Newman Centre, embarked upon a walking pilgrimage to Sacred Heart Church, Guelph. I'm grateful to all those parishioners who made these recent parish activities possible. If you weren't able to participate in them, please find ways to increase your own personal devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. To this end, I'm giving away copies of the Litany of Trust after the Sunday Masses to mark our parish feast. Copies will also be available in the sacristy for Adorers. Happy Feast Day!
