Pastor's Message

THE FALL

When we think of The Fall, we may be drawn to thoughts of our Fall from grace our need for Jesus Christ save us and redeem us. Although we are living through a challenging time as Catholics, we mustn't let the need for healing from the wounds of sin and division upon the Church distract us from continue to work together as a parish community to build up the kingdom of God here in Rockwood. Sacred Heart of Jesus, have mercy on us. Yet the Fall is also a time of renewed activity in the parish. Many of you attended the first Sunday 11:00am Mass at the school on September 9th with our new contemporary music ministry **The Divine Praises**. I encourage you to invite young people, especially high school students to this Mass. I would like it to become part of our **youth ministry** outreach. Stephen Roloson, our new music director, is very excited that this new initiative of our parish has begun. If you are interested in joining the new contemporary choir, or one of other choirs, please contact him. I've heard good things from parishioners about the Mass at the school as well as the changes to our music ministry over the summer, namely the introduction of the sung Kyrie and the sung responsorial psalm.

Some of you attended the **Opening School Mass** on Thursday, September 13th. It was a wonderful celebration. I was very impressed with response from the children when I asked them, "What is the Gospel?" Surprisingly, one of them said that it is the Cross. It is wonderful when the faith of children astounds us. Speaking of children, we are blessed to have one youth enrolled in the Rite of Christian Initiation for Children (**RCIC**). With the permission from the Bishop's Office, she will be baptized at the 9:00am Mass on Sunday, October 21st. If you know of other children in need of sacraments, please encourage their parents to contact me. Catechism classes resume on Wednesday, October 3rd. Please note that there will be a meeting for parents of children preparing for their **First Communion** in Coulson Hall at 6:00pm on Tuesday, October 2nd and a meeting for parents of children preparing for **Confirmation** in Coulson Hall at 6:00pm on Tuesday, October 9th.

Likewise, if you know an adult who is interested in becoming Catholic, please ask them to contact me in order to begin the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (**RCIA**). I heard from Dr. Jane Hosdil that some of you have responded to her call for more parishioners to join our Eucharistic Adoration ministry. If the Lord is moving you to join, it's not too late. Even if you don't formally join this ministry of prayer, feel free to drop by the church anytime during Adoration from after Mass Tuesday night to before Mass Friday morning. We have also had some parishioners volunteer for liturgical ministries and for our new Ministry to the Homebound.

All **Ministers of the Word** and **Ministers of Communion** are invited to attend our **Pastoral Council** meeting this coming Tuesday, September 18th at 7:45pm in Coulson Hall. We will be reviewing Bishop Crosby's liturgical guidelines entitled *Gathered Into One* and discussing how to implement it for our parish. There will also be a presentation about possibly doing a parish photo directory. I think we should do one. It's about time. But I'm not sure whether we should do it before or after moving into the new church on the hill at Camp Brebeuf. I'm hoping that we will be able to break ground in Spring 2019. However, first need to have our site plan approved by the Township. So please pray for that.

Please pray for all our parish endeavours, that they may be undertaken for the Glory of God.
And please pray for me.
