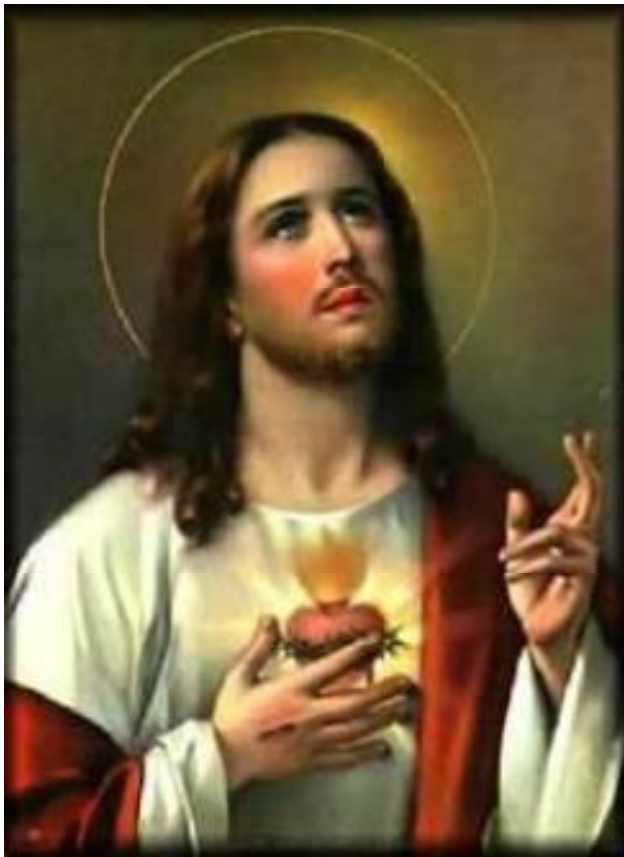

Pastor's Message

PASTORAL COUNCIL MEETING UPDATE

On Tuesday, January 15th I held a Pastoral Council meeting attended by thirteen ministers of the parish (Ministers of the Word and Ministers of Communion). I presented various items for their consideration and they gave me feedback and advice. Thank you to all of you who could attend. Here are my notes:

1. **Formed:** Although not all the ministers have registered yet, the feedback on FORMED was very positive. Those who have registered for the video streaming service known as Catholic "Netflix" have enjoyed the content and highly recommend it for others. I highly recommend a new series called "Elements of the Catholic Mass." I asked all the ministers to check it out. If you haven't obtained your free subscription, go to sacredheartrockwood.ca and click on the Formed tab.
2. **Christmas Season:** The feedback was positive concerning the Christmas and Mary Mother of God Masses and Mass schedule. We enjoyed wonderful celebrations in our parish over the holidays. One minister said that the Christmas Eve Mass at the school was "amazing." Thank you to our music director Stephen Roloson and to all of you who assisted me and participated in our celebrations.
3. **Adoration:** There was some confusion about the Adoration schedule over the Christmas Season. Some people thought that we were going with the Tuesday schedule after the Wednesday evening Masses. Although there was some confusion about whether Adoration began or ended at 10:00pm New Year's Eve, it was agreed that we should hold Adoration again after the Mass next year. Note that Adoration begins after Mass and ends with Benediction.
4. **Visiting Ministry:** We heard a report from the organizers of our ministry to the homebound. After Teresa Hartnett, the Director of our Diocesan Family Ministry Office, gave a presentation to our volunteers, we have decided to expand the scope of the ministry to include home visits in general, not just for the sick and the elderly. Our patroness will be Our Lady of the Visitation. Please contact Dr. Jane Hosdil if you are interested in joining the team. We will be asking parishioners the simple question: "Would you like a visit?"
5. **Hospitality:** Although hospitality ministry is going well, we are in need of more volunteers for the 5:00pm and the 9:00am Masses. There was some talk about whether we should hold hospitality on holidays. People were divided. My sense is that we should schedule it and if you can't do it, ask someone else to switch with you. There are people parishioners whose only opportunity to celebrate a holiday is with their parish family.
6. **Good Friday:** It was agreed that we should arrange for the food truck to return for fish and chips on Good Friday. I'm giving some thought as to whether we might use Coulson Hall or the Camp Brebeuf dining hall for those who want to socialize over a meal rather than use take-out. Note that we are once again planning to hold the Corpus Christi procession and the Sacred Heart Pilgrimage this year.
7. **Capital Campaign:** I talked little bit about our upcoming capital campaign for building the new church on the hill. There will be survey conducted at all Masses the weekends of February 9/10 and 16/17. More details to follow.
8. **Volunteers Needed:** We are in need of ushers, Ministers of the Word, Ministers of Communion, hospitality volunteers, altar servers and more volunteers to clean the church each week. **See chart on opposite page** and let me now if you might be able to contribute the life of our parish by giving of your time.
