

CAMP BREBEUF STAFF MASS


During the months of July and August there will be a Sunday Mass at 11:00am at Camp Brebeuf for the Camp staff and parishioners. Some of the staff live on site while others will be returning to Rockwood to begin their work week on Sunday afternoon. The Mass will take place in Chapel, also known as the Pavilion, indicated by the black building marked by the red cross in the upper right-hand corner of the map. Please park in the Parking Lot and walk over to the Chapel. I realize that the location is not for everyone. But feel free to check it out over the summer as we as a Parish continue to work more collaboratively with the Camp in support of youth ministry. This Mass will also give our 11:00am contemporary music choir an opportunity to continue to provide music ministry over the summer.

Hospitality after Mass will be offered in the Dining Hall. Just as Mass at the school is a temporary step towards building a new church, Mass at Camp is a step towards future collaboration between the Parish and the Camp. But not to worry. There will continue to be a Saturday Mass at 5:00pm and a Sunday Mass at 9:00am in the Church.

ROCKWOOD TRAIL RIDERS SINCE 1963

It is our understanding Sacred Heart Parish will be holding the 11:00 a.m. mass at Camp Brebeuf this summer. As you may be aware, on July 14th and August 11th we have our horse shows at the Dales farm. We start at 9:00 a.m. and continue throughout the entire day with arrivals beginning at 7:30 a.m. There will be trucks, trailers & other vehicles turning in and out of the field and riders walking their horses to & from the field to the barn-side entrance of the arenas throughout the day. Most of our riders are youth and some are under the age of 12. Horses, in spite of our best training, can startle easily and have a very strong flight instinct. The safety of our horses and riders is of utmost concern.



To that end, we ask you remind your parishioners to be vigilant while driving on Brebeuf Path PVT. Please ask them to keep their speed at the posted 10km speed (or less) and, they are to yield to horses & riders (according to the Highway Traffic Act).

We will have our members volunteer to assist in traffic control & calming. We will also ask our riders to be extra conscientious in their horsemanship while moving from parking to competition and back again to their trailers. We appreciate your co-operation and that of your parishioners in this matter, keeping the safety of everyone in mind.
