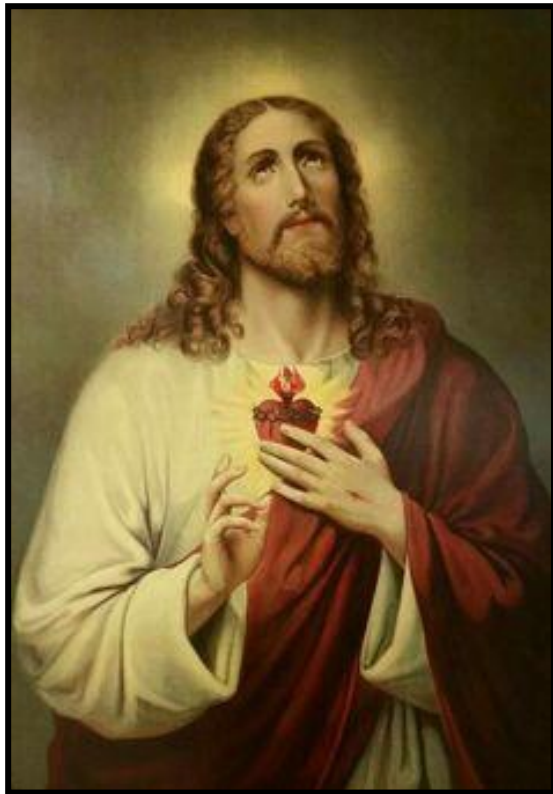

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Sunday Mass in the Church

When the Government of Ontario allowed churches to open and Bishop Crosby announced that Sunday Mass would begin on June 21st I was panicking. As excited as I was that churches would be open for Mass, with the physical distancing restrictions for places of worship, I calculated that we would only be allowed to use eight pews in our little church. That's enough seating for a weekday Mass. But not a Sunday Mass. In order to adhere to physical distancing and provide enough seats for Sunday Mass, I made an arrangement with the Wellington Catholic District School Board to use Sacred Heart School in June, July and August. Last year we celebrated Mass at Camp Brébeuf in the summer months. However, even the Pavilion would have been too small to accommodate large numbers with physical distancing. In God's Providence, I was relieved when the Board permitted me to book the school gym for the summer months. Although I realize that a gym isn't a church, over these past few Sundays it has been wonderful to celebrate Mass with our local Rockwood church community at the school. Even with the wearing of masks, I can see many familiar faces. And there's lots of room for physical distancing. My thought at the time of celebrating the first Mass back was that we would celebrate the Sunday Mass at 11:00 am in the school until September, when I was hoping that some of the restrictions would be lifted and enable us to accommodate more people in the church. At the same time, I decided to wait and see if the gym might fill up over the summer, in which case I thought we may need to use the church on Sunday as well. Over these past few Sundays, the number of parishioners attending Mass at the school has remained about the same. While I have considered resuming celebrating Sunday Mass in the church, the thought of turning people away when the church was full broke my heart.

However, during the Pastoral Council meeting held this past Tuesday evening over Zoom, I learned that some of our parishioners who would like to return to attending Sunday Mass are not able to attend the 11:00 am Mass at the school. I was not aware of this. When I expressed my concern that resuming Sunday Mass in the church would mean that people will be turned away I was told that this has become the "new normal". They said that churches in Guelph lock the doors when the available seating is full. I asked about the possibility of registering online for Sunday Mass in the church, but I was discouraged. In light of this new information, I have decided that we will resume the **Saturday 5:00 pm Mass on August 8th**. Nevertheless, this won't be as simple as it sounds. We will need volunteers to sanitize the church after the 5:00 pm Mass. This is the first step towards resuming the Sunday 9:00 am Mass in the church. I will also need to instruct ushers to help people find seating as well as instruct them to turn people away when the church fills up. I hope that you aren't one of those people who are turned away. If you are, please accept my apologies in advance. And please come back another time. One of my greatest fears as pastor is that someone will be turned away from Sunday Mass at the doors of the church and never return.

It pains me to think that the "new normal" in this time of encouraging people to return to the practice of the faith might mean that they have the doors of the church slammed in their face. All the more reason why we need to pray that our new Sacred Heart of Jesus Church will be built on the hill at Camp Brébeuf sooner rather than later. In his Letter to the Romans, St. Paul wrote: "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God. . . ." We love God. I love God. And so we trust that all things will work together according to God's plan for building a new church. Yet we also need to cooperate with God's plan. To this end, I'm happy to report that progress has been made in recent weeks with regards to meeting the requirement for constructing a new entrance to Camp Brébeuf. Please pray for those who may be turned away from the doors of old church and please pray that we will soon have a new church large enough to welcome all those who come to its doors.
