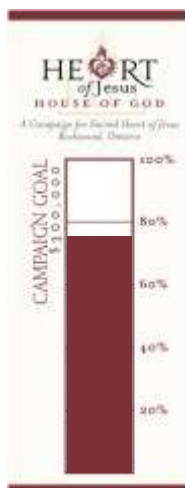
HEARTS SET ABLAZE RETREAT
